[Database Lets Agencies Keep Updated On Environmental Regulations](#)

This article discusses the creation of an online database of full-text environmental regulations, called EnviroText. The database was organized by the EPA and developed by the Army Corps of Engineers' Construction Engineering Research Laboratory with the assistance of the Department of Energy. The database covers federal and state rules on hazardous and solid waste, surface and groundwater quality, noise control, erosion and sedimentation, historic preservation, wetlands and endangered species. Documents can be searched by state, contaminant, cleanup technology, hydrogeologic terms, key words or legal citations.
