### Meeting to discuss wastewater permits at river watershed

To better inform the public about the upcoming re-issue of wastewater permits along the Saluda River Watershed, the Pucketts Ferry Homeowners Association will host an informational meeting 7 p.m. Thursday at the Pucketts Ferry Clubhouse.

Representatives from the Department of Health and Environmental Control will include Heather Preston, division director; Rebecca Spartlin; and Bob Jackson, regional director of the Water Quality Division.

John Tynan and Karen Blylan from Upstate Forever also will attend.

The meeting's focus will be to discuss legislation that would require technology upgrades for wastewater treatment plants, thus requiring them to lower the level of pollutants they release into the waters feeding Lake Greenwood. State Reps. Mike Pitts, Gene Pinson and Anne Parks, along with state Sen. Floyd Nicholson, and Jeff Duncan, a candidate for Senate will field questions. Joe Chandler and Bill Weeks, of Chandler Construction, will discuss construction run-off, and Julie Davis from Lake Management and county councilman Patrick Moody also will attend.
